Donate to a local social service organization. Go to www.westsideshelter.org

Place loose change in the Dolphin statues located on the Third Street Promenade (at Santa Monica Blvd.), on Main Street (at Ashland) and on the Santa Monica Pier. Money goes to local agencies that help the poor and homeless.

Don't leave food or clothing in public spaces! Food can quickly go bad or attract pests, while clothing can become litter.

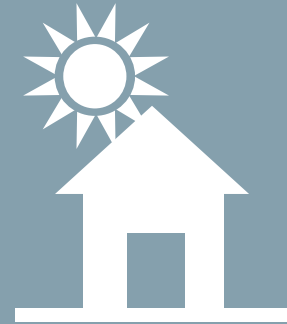
