# Rosie's Girls

**R**osie's Girls is an award winning summer program for girls, entering grades 6-8. It is designed to build self-esteem, physical confidence, friendships and leadership skills by providing an introduction to a wide range of trades, including carpentry, firefighting and tree trimming.

**Why Trades?** Whether in a shop or applied to "real world" projects, trades activities offer an unusual and especially powerful way for girls to develop a broader sense of themselves and their capabilities, learn self-reliance, and expand the range of careers they might envision for themselves.

While often considered appropriate for older (usually male) students, trades activities challenge girls to develop new areas of physical confidence, expand their math and science skills and succeed in areas they would typically avoid or hesitate to attempt.

**Why Rosie?** Rosie's Girls takes its name from the World War II icon, Rosie the Riveter, who represented women who went to work in shipyards and factories while men fought overseas. Their contributions did much to change the ideas about women's capabilities and helped pave the way for women to enter the workforce and consider careers outside the home.

**Program Activities** Rosie's Girls challenges girls to discover, develop, and enjoy their own capabilities in a supportive and caring environment. On Wednesdays and Fridays, girls will participate in field trips, physical challenges and community service. Over the three weeks, girls will take part in:

- ▲ Carpentry Instruction: Girls put these skills to use in shop-based projects and community service projects.
- ▲ Other Trades Experiences: Learning new skills such as welding, electrical wiring, plumbing, tree trimming, automotive repair and fire fighting.
- ▲ Creative Exploration: Daily activities such as dance, graphic design, mask making and creative writing.
- ▲ Physical Activities: Daily games and activities such as surfing, self-defense and rock-wall climbing encourage girls to recognize their physical strength.

Materials fee includes a jumpsuit, hardhat, work boots and program materials. Camp fees include daily afternoon snacks, field trip transportation and admissions. Campers must bring their own morning snack and daily sack lunch. We also recommend that campers bring a water bottle or water container and sunscreen.

Extended day is offered from 7:00 a.m. until the beginning of camp at 8:30 a.m. and from the end of camp at 5:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. each day. The extended day fee is \$35 a week.
