



Utility Users Tax Exemption Program
For low-income seniors and low-income individuals with a disability who reside within the
City of Santa Monica

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

If you are currently paying a City tax on your utility bills, you may be eligible for this program

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. 62 years of age or older, or meet the criteria of disability as established by the Social Security Administration's supplemental security income program for the aged, blind and disabled (Title XVI of the Social Security Act, as amended).
2. Santa Monica resident
3. May not exceed \$26,152 annual gross income for one person household (Effective July 1, 2008)
4. May not exceed \$29,968 annual gross income for two or more person households (Effective July 1, 2008)
5. Utility bill must be in applicant's name

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED:

1. A copy of a current California I.D. or Drivers License
2. A copy of the most recent utility bill: Electric, Water, Wastewater, Gas, Telephone, Cable T.V.
3. A copy of your proof of income, such as a Social Security statement or Tax Return
4. A copy of bank statements or other documentation showing any interest income or inheritances
5. If applying as a person with a disability, please bring verification such as documentation from a physician, rehabilitation counselor, independent living counselor, a disability related organization or proof of SSI/SDI
6. All copies must be made prior to submitting paperwork
