Section I
CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION RECYCLING REQUIREMENTS
Building Permit Applicant Guidelines

Construction and Demolition Debris Ordinance #1996

A Santa Monica City Council Ordinance passed on 12/19/00 amended the Municipal Code to require that certain construction and demolition projects achieve sixty percent (60%) waste diversion rates. As part of these requirements, some documents and a performance security deposit must be submitted as part of the building permit application process. The documentation must demonstrate the permit applicants intent and ability to divert 60% of the waste generated by the project from landfill disposal through recycling and reuse of materials. The Ordinance further requires that documentation of the 60% diversion rate be submitted at the completion of the project as a condition of returning the performance security.

Types of projects covered by this Ordinance

Any private construction or demolition project which is projected to cost \$50,000 or more or which are 1,000 square feet or greater in size is covered by the requirements of this Ordinance. In addition, all City-sponsored construction, demolition and renovation projects, regardless of size, are covered by the Ordinance.

Diversion Rate Requirements

A diversion rate of 60% is required for all waste generated by each covered project. No more than 20% of the diversion rate can be achieved through the recycling or reuse of source separated inerts; the balance must be diverted through recycling or reuse of structural materials and other waste generated by the project.

Permit Application Requirements

As part of the building permit application, applicants for projects covered by the Ordinance must comply with two requirements as part of the building or demolition permit process:

1. Applicants must complete and submit a Waste Management Plan (WMP) on a City-approved WMP form. (see attached)
2. Applicants must submit an appropriate performance security, with the WMP in the amount of three percent of total project cost, up to a maximum of \$30,000. Demolition only permits must submit a performance security in the amount of three percent of total project cost, with a minimum \$1,000 performance security. In the ordinance "Performance Security" means any performance bond, surety bond, money order, letter of credit, certificate of deposit, or restricted bank account, provided to the City of Santa Monica.

- a) Applicants for over-the-counter permits will receive their permits prior to review of the WMP by City staff. Subsequent review by City staff may result in requirements to amend the plan. Applicants for all other project permits covered under ordinance must have their WMP reviewed and approved by City staff prior to the issuance of any building permit.

Any subsequent changes must be pre-approved in writing by City staff in order to ensure return of performance security.

Within 30 days after the completion of any covered project, the permit applicant must submit a Waste Management Final Compliance Report Form describing the efforts used to meet the diversion requirements and quantifying diversion rates. Receipts documenting the actual weight or volume of all materials recycled, reused, or disposed of from the project must be attached to the WMP Final Compliance Report Form.

When demonstrating compliance with the diversion requirements and obtaining release of the performance security all receipts must have project address printed on them.

City staff will review the information and determine **within two weeks** whether the applicant has fully complied with the diversion requirements of the Ordinance. If the City determines that documentation demonstrates full compliance with the Ordinance, the full performance security shall be released. If the diversion requirements have not been met, the City will return a portion of the performance security equivalent to the extent to which the project has met the 60% diversion goal (e.g. if only half of the diversion goal has been reached, only half of the performance security will be returned). The balance of the performance security will be forfeited.

Forfeited performance security

Any forfeited performance security will be used to recover City costs associated with recycling mixed C&D loads brought to the City transfer station and recycling center.

Exemptions from diversion requirements

An applicant may apply for an exemption to the 60% diversion requirement at the time of the submittal of the WMP. The WMP must still be filled out, with data indicating what diversion percentage the applicant considers feasible. In addition, a Waiver Request Form must be completed that indicates the reasons the applicant is requesting an exemption from the diversion requirements this form can be obtained by contacting Gus Guzzetti at (310) 458-8714. Exemptions will be considered based on lack of on-site storage space, contamination by hazardous materials, and low recyclability of specific materials. Exemption requests must be approved prior to issuance of the building permit (including over-the-counter permits).

Technical assistance to applicants

The City will provide information about potential service providers through written lists (See attached Contractors Guide to Reuse and Recycling) and future web site information. It will also ensure that materials delivered to the City Transfer Station and Recycling Center are sorted for recycling and documentation on diversion rates for delivered loads will be provided upon request. Average diversion rates for loads delivered to the City Transfer Station and Recycling Center exceed 80%.

Information about permitted haulers and recyclers and C&D recycling facilities are included in this package and on the City's web site, www.santa-monica.org.

Transportation of Construction and Demolition Debris

The City of Santa Monica requires that all haulers of recyclables and waste materials within City boundaries obtain a private hauler permit from the Solid Waste Management Division. For a list of permitted haulers see attached, or to refer a new hauler or recycler for a hauler permit with the city, please contact: Gus Guzzetti, Solid Waste Management Division (310) 458-8714.

The one exception is in the case of loads self-hauled by the construction or demolition contractor or their construction subcontractors (e.g. carpentry, wallboard, etc.).

Self-hauling is defined as hauling which meets three criteria:

- a) It is incidental to a construction or demolition company's primary business;
- b) It is done in a vehicle owned by the same construction or demolition company;
- and,
- c) The vehicle is driven by one of that construction or demolition company's employees.
